Built with partners. Powered by community. We kept families housed.

In early 2026, **hundreds of Rochester-area families lost income overnight** — not from a job loss or personal crisis, but because fear made leaving home impossible. Hope at Home was built in a week to meet this moment. Over six weeks, Family Promise Rochester deployed significant rapid-response funding prioritizing **speed, privacy, and partner referrals** to help families and children remain safely housed.

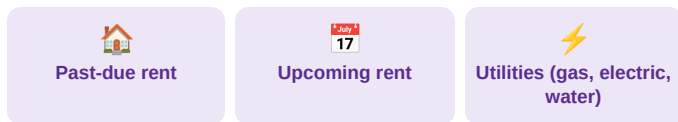

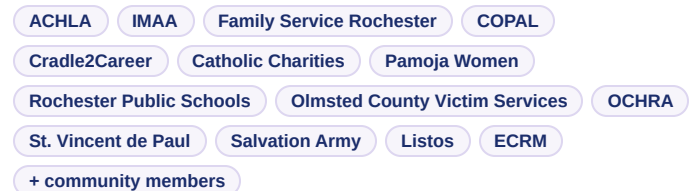

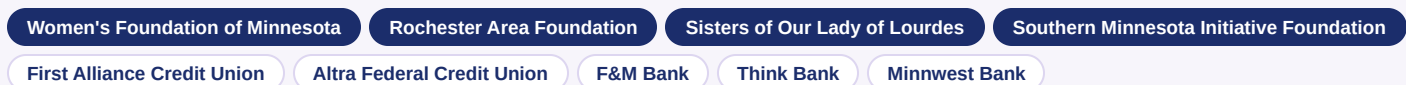
